

3. Almost all the food is homemade by local Melrose Park residents based on traditional family recipes... we even have nuns from a local convent selling a dessert.
4. It is the only area food festival where all food items cost \$3 or less.
5. The entertainment on our 4 stages is free, as is the parking and shuttle service.
6. Only food festival where the proceeds from the sale of beverages goes to a charity.  
Nearly \$1,000,000 raised for local youth, seniors, and school organizations!
