ORDINANCE NO. 931

**AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING A CERTAIN SCRIVENER'S ERROR
IN ORDINANCE 925 OF THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY
OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, State of Illinois ("the Village") is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President, the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005 and the Village Board of Trustees, the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Ruben Lomeli, Trustee Arturo J. Mota and Anthony J. Prignano, having taken office on May 2, 2005, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2005, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park passed and adopted Ordinance 925, entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND FINANCE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY /EQUIPMENT (TWO FORD FIVE HUNDRED SE VEHICLES), FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS" (hereinafter "Ordinance 925"); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to correct a certain error contained within Ordinance 925, which is attached hereto, because Ordinance 925 contains a certain scrivener's

error. Correction of said scrivener's error will not alter the purpose and intent of Ordinance 925 adopted by the Village Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, Illinois:

**ARTICLE 1
IN GENERAL**

Section 1.0 Incorporation Clause.

The Village Board hereby finds that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 2.0 Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to correct a certain scrivener's error contained in Ordinance 925.

Section 3.0 Invocation of Authority.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to this Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 4.0 State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Sections 05-09. Reserved.

**ARTICLE II
CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERROR**

Section 10.00 Correction of Vehicle Identification Number.

The aforesaid Scrivener's error is hereby corrected by making the following corrections:

Section 10.00 Acceptance of Bid.

That the bid from Elmhurst Motors, Inc for the sale of certain equipment, more particularly described as two (2) 2005 Ford Five Hundred SE vehicles, is hereby accepted and the Village of Melrose Park, by and through its authorized agents, is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire said equipment and to take all necessary action associated therewith. The equipment is more particularly identified by Vehicle Identification Numbers 1FAFP231156160365 and 1FAFP23185G151954;

The above provision includes a correction required to eliminate a certain scrivener's error and to conform Ordinance 925 to that which was intended to be included but was not properly written due to a scrivener's error.

Section 11.00 Reserved.

**ARTICLE III
SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 12.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs, and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of the reference and form no substantive part of the Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 13.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute, or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

Section 14.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

Section 15.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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Section 16.00 Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.


