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CHAPTER 5, GENERAL LICENSING ORDINANCE, OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE OF MELROSE PARK OF 1970, AND
ORDINANCE NO. 737, FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK,
COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

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WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, State of Illinois (“the Village”) is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President, the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005 and the Village Board of Trustees, the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Ruben Lomeli, Trustee Arturo J. Mota and Anthony J. Prignano, having taken office on May 2, 2005, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park has a substantial governmental interest in licensing the entities that seek to do business and do business within the corporate limits of the Village of Melrose Park; and

WHEREAS, currently there is in full force and effect, in the Village of Melrose Park, a certain ordinance and a municipal code provision concerning the classifications of licenses and license fees for Melrose Park businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village hereby find and determine that it is in the best interests of the Village to adopt a certain amendment to the Village's General Licensing Ordinance as contained herein; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 01. Incorporation Clause.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board") hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 02. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 5, General Licensing Ordinance, of the Municipal Code of Melrose Park of 1970 and Ordinance No. 737.

Section 03. Invocation of Authority.

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the police powers and authority granted to this Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 04. State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Sections 05-09. Reserved.

ARTICLE II.
AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 5 AND ORDINANCE NO. 737

Section 10.00 Amendment to Village Code, Chapter 5, Section 5.7. & Ordinance No. 737.

That the Village Code, Chapter 5, General Licensing Ordinance, Section 5.7, License Fees, and Ordinance No. 737 are hereby amended, notwithstanding any ordinances, resolutions, or code provisions to the contrary, by addition of the following Sub-category of business and fee:

Business License
Miscellaneous Business
Category #11

<u>Sub-category of Business:</u>	<u>License Fee:</u>
Garage, Rummage and Similar Sales	\$5.00 per day

Chapter 5, Section 5.7 of the Village Code and Ordinance No. 737 shall hereinafter be codified to reflect the amendments provided for herein. To that extent that any clause, paragraph, sub-paragraph or sentence ("section") conflicts herewith, this Ordinance shall supercede such section and such section shall thereby be repealed.

Section 11.00 Other Actions Authorized.

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the amendments contemplated by this Ordinance and to take all action necessary in conformity therewith. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms to be utilized in connection with the amendments made herein.

**ARTICLE III.
SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 12.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs, and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 13.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Board of Trustees that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof had not been included.

Section 14.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

Section 15.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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Section 16.00 Effective date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.
