**ORDINANCE NO. 945**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED  
“AMENDING CHAPTER 178 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE  
OF MELROSE PARK, 1975, BY ADDING SECTION 12, TO SAID  
CHAPTER 178, RELATING TO CONNECTIONS TO WATER  
SYSTEM” FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY  
OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, State of Illinois (“the Village”) is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President, the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005 and the Village Board of Trustees, the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Ruben Lomeli, Trustee Arturo J. Mota and Anthony J. Prignano, having taken office on May 2, 2005, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1977, the Village of Melrose Park passed an Ordinance entitled “Amending Chapter 178, of the Code of the Village of Melrose Park, 1975, by Adding Section 12, to Said Chapter 178, Relating to Connections to Water System” (hereinafter the “Ordinance”); and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interest of the Village and its inhabitants to make a certain amendment to the Ordinance, “amending Chapter 178, of the Code of the Village of Melrose Park, 1975, by Adding Section 12, to Said Chapter 178, Relating to Connections to Water System”; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.  
IN GENERAL**

**Section 01. Incorporation Clause.**

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board”) hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance.

**Section 02. Purpose.**

The purpose of this ordinance is to make a certain amendment to the Ordinance.

**Section 03. Invocation of Authority.**

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to this Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

**Section 04. State Law Adopted.**

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

**Sections 05-09. Reserved.**

**ARTICLE II.  
AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1 OF THE ORDINANCE**

**Section 10.00 Repeal of Section 1, "Water Tap" of the Ordinance.**

Section 1, "Water Tap," of the Ordinance, is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety by the following provision:

Section 1: Water Tap:

Any qualified master plumber having a State of Illinois, Department of Public Health current certification, desiring to make any connection or tap into the water system of the Village of Melrose Park, either on public or private property must first obtain a permit from the Director of Public Works via the Building Department and pay the required tap-in fee as set forth below:

Minimum Water Tap Size is 1"

1"	Water Tap	\$ 450.00
1 ½"	Water Tap	550.00
2"	Water Tap	650.00
3"	Water Tap	750.00
4"	Water Tap	850.00
6"	Water Tap	950.00
8"	Water Tap	1,050.00
10"	Water Tap	1,150.00
12"	Water Tap	1,250.00

Applicants for a Water Tap Permit must also apply for and obtain a plumbing permit from the Village of Melrose Park prior to tapping into the Village of Melrose Park Water System. The Director of Public Works and the Village of Melrose Park Water Department must approve any and all plans and methods for the tapping of Village of Melrose Park Water System prior to the commencement of the work to be performed.

This schedule of fees is for the right to tap into the Village of Melrose Park Water System only. Any digging, boring, restoration of streets, sidewalks and/or grassy areas is the responsibility of the applicant. Any work performed by the Village of Melrose Park employees in connection with tapping into the Village of Melrose Park Water System will be charged on a cost basis.

**ARTICLE III.  
SAVINGS CLAUSES,  
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Section 11.00 Headings.**

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 12.00 Severability.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this

Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Board of Trustees that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof had not been included.

**Section 14.00 Superseder.**

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

**Section 15.00 Publication.**

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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**Section 16.00 Effective date**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.


