ORDINANCE NO. 952

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2006, FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK,
COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

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WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, State of Illinois (“the Village”) is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President, the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005 and the Village Board of Trustees, the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Ruben Lomeli, Trustee Arturo J. Mota and Anthony J. Prignano, having taken office on May 2, 2005, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 381 and Ordinance No. 382, the Board of Trustees of the Village has adopted the “Budget Officer System” as provided in the Illinois Compiled Statutes, as amended; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Ordinances and the Statutes of the State of Illinois made and provided, an annual budget shall be adopted by the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Melrose Park in lieu of the passage of any appropriation ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park has held all of the hearings and caused to be made all of the publications and notices in connection with the adoption of its annual budget as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Budget for Fiscal Year 2006 has been and currently is conveniently available for public inspection in the Village Clerk's office and the principal office of the Village of Melrose Park, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park has reviewed the budget for Fiscal Year 2006 and determined said budget to be in the best interests of the Village of Melrose Park; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 01. Incorporation Clause.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board") hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of the Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 02. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to adopt the Village of Melrose Park Budget for fiscal year 2006.

Section 03. Invocation of Authority.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to this Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 04. State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Sections 05-09. Reserved.

**ARTICLE II.
ADOPTION OF ANNUAL BUDGET**

Section 10.00 Adoption of Annual Budget.

That the Fiscal Year, 2006 Budget for the Village of Melrose Park, Illinois, attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof as "Exhibit A," is hereby adopted and approved. Approved Budgets of Departments, Functions, Boards and Commissions, as stated in Exhibit A, the Municipal Budget, may not be increased without approval by the Board of Trustees of the Village. Budget transfers within Departments, Functions, Boards and Commissions do not require approval from the Board of Trustees of the Village, however, such transfers shall be subject to the approval of the Village Budget Officer.

**ARTICLE III.
SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 11.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 12.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Board of Trustees that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof had not been included.

Section 13.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

Section 14.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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Section 15.00 Effective date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.




