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AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF "DIRECTOR OF SEASONAL OPERATIONS" AND APPOINTING A CERTAIN INDIVIDUAL TO SAID POSITION, FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

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WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, State of Illinois ("the Village") is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President, the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005 and the Village Board of Trustees, the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Ruben Lomeli, Trustee Arturo J. Mota and Anthony J. Prignano, having taken office on May 2, 2005, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Statute, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-5, the President is vested with the power and authority to create positions and make appointments thereto as may be necessary to carry out and give effect the powers conferred upon municipalities; and

WHEREAS, there currently exists a need within the Village of Melrose Park to create a certain appointed position to, among other things, oversee and carry-out the duties associated with seasonal projects of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees (the "Corporate Authorities") of the Village of Melrose Park have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to create the position of Director of Seasonal Operations and to appoint a certain individual to said position; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 01. Incorporation Clause.

The Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board") hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 02. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to create the position of Director of Seasonal Operations and appoint a certain individual to said position.

Section 03. Invocation of Authority.

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to this Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 04. State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Sections 05-09. Reserved.

**ARTICLE II.
CREATION OF POSITION.**

Section 10.00 Director of Seasonal Operations.

That the Village President and Board of Trustees hereby authorize the creation of the position of Director of Seasonal Operations.

Section 10.01 Duties and Responsibilities of Director of Seasonal Operation.

That the Director of Seasonal Operations shall coordinate, oversee and manage the operations of landscaping crews, snow removal crews and the installation and placement of seasonal decorations throughout the community.

Section 10.02 Employee Status.

That the Director of Seasonal Operations shall be an employee of the Village.

Section 11.00 Appointment of Director of Seasonal Operations.

That the President and Board of Trustees of the Village do hereby authorize the appointment of MICHAEL DE VITA as Director of Seasonal Operations.

Section 11.01 Effectiveness of Appointment.

That this appointment shall be effective on May 1, 2006 and shall expire on April 30, 2007.

Section 11.02 Term of Appointment.

That the position of Director of Seasonal Operations shall be subject to annual appointment by the Village President. Commencing after the expiration of the term of office set forth in Section 11.01 above, the term of office for said position shall thereafter begin on May 1st of each year and expire on April 30th, of the following year.

**ARTICLE III.
SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 16.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 17.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Board of Trustees that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof had not been included.

Section 18.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

Section 19.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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Section 20.00 Effective date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.




