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AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN CHAPTERS FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK SAFETY PROGRAM MANUAL FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

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WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, State of Illinois (“the Village”) is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President, the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005 and the Village Board of Trustees, the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Ruben Lomeli, Trustee Arturo J. Mota and Anthony J. Prignano, having taken office on May 2, 2005, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 802, approving the adoption of a Safety Program Manual for the Village, a Safety Program Manual was created and updated by the Village Safety Review Board and the Village Safety Director; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees, in an effort to continuously ensure that the Village of Melrose Park is in strict observance of all laws, and is an efficient, productive, and hazard free work place, revises and implements policies and procedures from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Village Safety Review Board and Safety Director have updated and revised the Safety Program Manual by the creation of Chapter 20 and 21 (hereinafter the “Chapters”) for the Village of Melrose Park Safety Program Manual to reflect subsequent state and local legislative enactments, and recent administrative policy implementations; and

WHEREAS, due to subsequent state and local legislative enactments, and recent administrative policy implementations, the President and Board of Trustees deem it necessary to implement the new Chapters for the Village of Melrose Park Safety Program Manual governing the safety policies and procedures for the Village of Melrose Park and its employees; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of the effective and safe administration of the Village and its departments, the President and the Board of Trustees (the “Corporate Authorities”) of the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, have determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the Village to authorize and approve the adoption of the new Chapters for the Village of Melrose Park Safety Program Manual, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, to supercede and completely replace any former chapters 20 and 21; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, Illinois:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 01. Incorporation Clause.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board”) hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this

Ordinance are full, true and correct and does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance.

Section 02. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize and approve certain new Chapters in the Safety Program Manual for the Village of Melrose Park.

Section 03. Invocation of Authority.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to this Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 04. State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Sections 05-09. Reserved.

**ARTICLE II.
ADOPTION OF SAFETY PROGRAM MANUAL**

Section 10.00 Authorization to Adopt New Chapters for Safety Program Manual.

That the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park do hereby authorize, approve and adopt the new Chapters to the Safety Program Manual for the Village, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A." The new Chapters to the Safety Program Manual of the Village, attached hereto, supercede and completely replace any previous chapters 20 or 21 of the Safety Program Manual of the Village adopted by Ordinance 802.

**ARTICLE III.
SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 13.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 14.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Board of Trustees that this ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof had not been included.

Section 15.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

Section 16.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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Section 17.00 Effective date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.


