**ORDINANCE NO. 1059**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A CERTAIN CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President (the "President"), the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi (the "Clerk"), having taken office on May 2, 2005, and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board"), the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Tom "T.K." Klein, Arturo J. Mota, Anthony J. Prignano and Mary Ramirez Taconi having taken office on May 14, 2007, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Village Board (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") have determined that numerous issues routinely present themselves before the Illinois General Assembly, the Illinois state executive offices and its departments and agencies (the "State Government"), whether legislatively or administratively, which can and do impact the workings of the Village, both fiscally and programmatically; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Village should

be represented in a formal capacity by a governmental affairs consultant and lobbying firm before State Government to monitor and have input on these State Government activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Village shall enter into a contract for personal services for the aforesaid representation, as more particularly described in the contract attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A" (the "Contract"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has previously appropriated, allocated or budgeted sufficient funds for the Contract, the funds are readily available, and the Village intends to use the aforementioned funds to pay for the services and materials to be provided as described in the Contract; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.  
IN GENERAL**

**Section 01. Incorporation Clause.**

All of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct, and the Village Board does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section 02. Purpose.**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the President or his designee to enter into the Contract with Alfred G. Ronan, Ltd. ("Ronan") for Ronan to serve the Village as the governmental affairs consultant and lobbying firm before State Government in accordance with the terms of the Contract, and to authorize and direct the

President or his designee to execute all necessary documents and perform all necessary services to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

**Section 03. Invocation of Authority.**

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

**Section 04. State Law Adopted.**

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

**ARTICLE II.  
AUTHORIZATION AND APPROVAL**

**Section 05. Authorization of Contract.**

The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the Contract in substantially the same form as attached hereto, authorize and direct the President or his designee to execute the Contract, and authorize and direct the expenditure of all costs related thereto or resulting therefrom.

**Section 06. Approval and Execution of Documents.**

The Contract is hereby approved in substantially the same form as attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" with such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney. The President or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to complete and execute the Contract and any other documents deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, whether or not such other documents are attached hereto. The Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to, countersign and affix the seal of the Village to all such documents as

are deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

**Section 07. Other Actions Authorized.**

The officers and employees of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this Ordinance and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated hereby, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

**Section 08. Acts of Village Officials.**

That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Ordinance are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

**Section 09. – Section 15.00 Reserved.**

**ARTICLE III.  
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES,  
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Section 16.00 Headings.**

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 17.00 Severability.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this

Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Village Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof been included.

**Section 18.00 Superseder.**

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**Section 19.00 Publication.**

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.




