**ORDINANCE NO. 1294**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President (the “President”), the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk (the “Village Clerk”), the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board”), the Honorable Cathleen Cossident Italia, Anthony J. Prignano, Arturo J. Mota, Mary Ramirez Taconi, Jaime Anguiano and Anthony N. Abruzzo, having taken office on April 30, 2009, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, it is no longer necessary or useful for the Village to retain ownership of a certain ambulance or certain surplus equipment and materials hereinafter described; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Village Board have determined it is in the best public interest to donate the aforesaid items as set forth herein; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the president and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.  
IN GENERAL**

**Section 01. Incorporation Clause.**

All of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct, and the Corporate Authorities do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section 02. Purpose.**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the donation of a surplus vehicle and certain medical/health care items with the ownership of said items having been deemed by the President and Village Board as unnecessary.

**Section 03. Invocation of Authority.**

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

**Section 04. State Law Adopted.**

All applicable provision of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, related to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 05- Section 09. Reserved.**

**ACTICLE II.  
AUTHORIZATION FOR DONATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY**

**Section 10.00 Donation of Personal Property.**

The Village does hereby authorize the donation of a surplus ambulance and certain items of personal property including but not limited to certain surplus hospital beds, walkers, therapy beds and collateral items thereto to the Federacion Jalisciense del Medio Oeste with the intention

of contributing the same to the State of Jalisco, Mexico to carry out its services. The Village President shall execute all necessary documentation to effectuate this donation including any transfer of title documentation regarding the vehicle and either a letter or “Bill of Sale” enumerating the related personal property being donated. Upon execution of the same, the documents shall be incorporated herein by this reference. All actions taken to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance are hereby ratified.

**Section 10.01 Authorization to Donate**

That the Village President, and/or the Village Comptroller and/or a designee is/are hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to effectuate the donation of the items referenced above.

**Section 11.00-Section 15.00. Reserved.**

**ARTICLE III.  
SAVINGS CLAUSES,  
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Section 16.00 Headings.**

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 17.00 Severability.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is

hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Village Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part thereof been included.

**Section 18.00 Repeal of Prior Ordinances.**

All prior ordinances and resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

**Section 19.00 Publication.**

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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**Section 20.00 Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.


