**ORDINANCE NO. 1396**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OR SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President (the “President”), the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board”), the Honorable Cathleen Cossident Italia, Anthony J. Prignano, Arturo J. Mota, Mary Ramirez Taconi, Jaime Anguiano and Anthony N. Abruzzo, having taken office on April 30, 2009, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village owns a certain vehicle (the “Vehicle”), which is described in the documentation attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), a majority of the corporate authorities may authorize the sale of personal property in such manner as they may designate, with or without advertising the sale; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Village Board (collectively, the “Corporate Authorities”) have determined that the Vehicle is surplus property and, therefore, is no longer

necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of, the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities hereby determine that the Vehicle is surplus and is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of, the Village and authorize the President or his designee to sell the Vehicle; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.  
IN GENERAL**

**Section 01. Incorporation Clause.**

All of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct, and the Corporate Authorities do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section 02. Purpose.**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the disposal or sale of the Vehicle, which the Corporate Authorities have determined is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of, the Village.

**Section 03. Invocation of Authority.**

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

**Section 04. State Law Adopted.**

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 05 – Section 09. Reserved.**

**ARTICLE II.**  
**AUTHORIZATION FOR SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY BY PUBLIC AUCTION**

**Section 10.00 Sale of Personal Property.**

Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the following personal property is hereby declared to be surplus and is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of, the Village. It is hereby found that the Village would be best served by the disposal or sale of the following Vehicle: one (1) 2005 Ford Crown Victoria with a Vehicle Identification Number of 2FAFP71W15X112421 and License Plate Number of M149236.

**Section 10.01 Authorization to Direct Disposal or Sale.**

That the President, his designee and/or the Director of Purchasing are hereby authorized to direct the sale or disposal of the Vehicle.

**Section 10.02 Authorization to Enter into Agreement, if Necessary.**

That the President, his designee and/or the Director of Purchasing are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the disposal or sale of the Vehicle, if such is deemed necessary.

**Section 10.03 Authorization to Convey Title.**

That the President, his designee and/or the Director of Purchasing are hereby authorized to convey title of the Vehicle upon its disposal or sale.

**Sections 11.00 – 15.00 Reserved.**

**ARTICLE III.**  
**HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES,**  
**PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Section 16.00 Headings.**

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this

Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 17.00 Severability.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Village Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part thereof been included.

**Section 18.00 Superseder.**

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**Section 19.00 Publication.**

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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**Section 20.00 Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
