**ORDINANCE NO. 1431**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 737 TITLED, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A CERTAIN SECTION OF CHAPTER 5, GENERAL LICENSING ORDINANCE, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF MELROSE PARK OF 1970, AND ORDINANCE NO. 383, FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS."**

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President (the "President"), the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board"), the Honorable Cathleen Cossident Italia, Anthony J. Prignano, Arturo J. Mota, Mary Ramirez Taconi, Jaime Anguiano and Anthony N. Abruzzo, having taken office on April 30, 2009, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2003, the President and the Village Board (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") adopted Ordinance No. 737 titled, "An Ordinance Amending A Certain Section of Chapter 5, General Licensing Ordinance, of the Municipal Code of Melrose Park of 1970, and Ordinance No. 383, for the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois" ("Ordinance No. 737"); and

**WHEREAS**, in an effort to update the fees, rules and regulations of the Village, the Corporate Authorities, from time to time, revise and amend certain ordinances and sections of The Village of Melrose Park Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, to that end, the Corporate Authorities desire to amend Ordinance No. 737; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure the Village operates in an effective and efficient manner, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interest of the Village to amend Ordinance No. 737, as set forth below; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.  
IN GENERAL**

**Section 01. Incorporation Clause.**

All of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct, and the Village Board does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section 02. Purpose.**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. 737 to update the fees therein.

**Section 03. Invocation of authority.**

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the police powers and the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

**Section 04. State Law Adopted.**

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

**Sections 05-09. Reserved.**

**ARTICLE II.  
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 737.**

**Section 10.00 Amendment to Ordinance No. 737.**

That Exhibit A to Ordinance No. 737 is hereby amended, notwithstanding any ordinance, resolution or code provision to the contrary, by replacing the subsection of Exhibit A thereon, titled "Business License, Industrial, Category #3" by removing the currently attached subsection and replacing it with the subsection "Business License, Industrial, Category #3", attached hereto and incorporated herein as Schedule A.

**ARTICLE III.  
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES,  
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Section 11.00 Headings.**

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 12.00 Severability.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of

competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Village Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part thereof been included.

**Section 13.00 Superseder.**

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded.

**Section 14.00 Publication.**

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

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**Section 15.00 Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.


