Dear Resident and/or Property Owner:

I am pleased to inform you that your alley is included in an alley reconstruction project for this year. The project is scheduled to begin this month and should be completed by the end of September. The attached map shows all alleys included in the program.

The project consists of concrete alley construction, which involves removing all existing alley pavement, pouring 8" of concrete alley pavement, and replacing garage aprons to meet the new alley pavement.

You will receive a NOTICE from the Contractor about 2 days before the date your alley will be closed and beginning that date you will NOT HAVE ACCESS to your garage through the alley for about four weeks. In that notice you will be asked to park your vehicles in front of your home or on the closest intersecting street. Alternate side parking restrictions will not be enforced while the alley is closed. During alley closure, garbage collection will be at the curb line on the street IN FRONT of your home on your regularly scheduled day of collection. You will again be notified once the alley is reopened and garbage pickup and parking regulations return to normal.

Preliminary work may be done on sewers before the alley is closed, and the sewer contractor will work with you to make sure you can get in and out of your garage. Until you are notified of your alley being closed, please continue to observe the alternate-side parking regulations, and continue to place your garbage in the alley on your scheduled garbage pickup date.

Please help the Village and the contractor to protect the freshly poured concrete for the first 24 hours by immediately reporting any graffiti or damage you see to our Project Liaison below.

I realize that you will encounter inconveniences during this project, but I know that you will appreciate a newly improved alley when the job is finished.
