The Melrose Park Village Clerk is a registrar for voters and the local election authority.

Registration information must be transferred to the new address if a registered resident moves within Melrose Park.

Residents who are 18 or older and are U.S. citizens can register to vote in local, state and federal elections during regular business hours 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, in the first floor offices in the Melrose Park Civic Center, 1000 25th Ave.

Voter registration requires two types of identification, at least one with the current address. A driver's license or state picture ID is preferred, along with an additional item such as a lease or utility bill.
