ORDINANCE NO. 1204

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A PROPOSAL AND CONTRACT FOR SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH LIBRARY FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS, FOR THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the “President”), the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk (the “Village Clerk”), the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, having taken office on May 2, 2005, and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board”), the Honorable John S. Conteduca, Cathleen Cossident Italia, Arturo J. Mota, Anthony J. Prignano, and Mary Ramirez Taconi, having taken office on May 14, 2007, and the Honorable Jaime Anguiano, having taken office on March 10, 2008, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Village Board (collectively, the “Corporate Authorities”) declare it necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to have necessary repairs and maintenance performed at the Village public library building, located at 801 Broadway Avenue in the Village, specifically the installation of a handicapped-accessible ramp for ingress to and egress from the library building (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Village, in order to find a contractor to perform the work related to the Project, advertised for bids and received bids from three (3) prospective bidders; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that J.L.C.C., Inc., (the “Contractor”) is the lowest responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has agreed to perform the work for the Project, as more particularly described in the Proposal dated July 10, 2008, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit “A” (the “Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously appropriated, allocated or budgeted sufficient funds for the Project, the funds are readily available, and the Village intends to use the aforementioned funds to pay for the services and materials to be provided as described in the Proposal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 01. Incorporation Clause.

All of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct, and the President and Village Board do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 02. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to approve the Proposal, to authorize the President or his designee to draft and enter into a contract between the Village and the Contractor incorporating the terms of the Proposal, to authorize and direct the President to execute all necessary

documents, and perform all necessary services to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, including the expenditure of all necessary funds.

Section 03. Invocation of Authority.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 04. State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Section 05 – Section 09. Reserved.

**ARTICLE II.
AUTHORIZATION AND APPROVAL**

Section 10.00. Approval of Proposal; Authorization of Contract.

The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the Proposal for the Contractor to perform the work for the Project; the Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the President, the Village Attorney and/or their designee(s) to draft a contract incorporating the terms of the Proposal, all requirements of the Village Code of Ordinances and the Illinois Compiled Statutes, and all other insertions as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney for execution by the Contractor and the Village. The President or his designee is then hereby authorized and directed to finalize and execute the aforesaid contract and any other documents deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, whether or not such other documents are attached hereto. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to, countersign and affix the seal of the Village to all such documents as are deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance. The Village is authorized to allocate and spend all necessary funds to

fulfill the requirements of the aforesaid contract and of this Ordinance.

Section 10.02. Other Actions Authorized.

The officers and employees of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this Ordinance and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated hereby, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

Section 10.03. Acts of Village Officials.

That all past, present, and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Ordinance are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

Section 11.00 – Section 15.00 Reserved.

**ARTICLE III.
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 16.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and sub-paragraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 17.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent

jurisdiction, said provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the President and Village Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, sub-paragraph, section, or part thereof been included.

Section 18.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 19.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.
