ORDINANCE NO. 1306

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A CERTAIN REQUEST FOR PAYMENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2009 SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE PROJECT, IN THE VILLAGE OF MELROSE PARK, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the “President”), the Honorable Ronald M. Serpico, the Village Clerk, the Honorable Mary Ann Paolantonio Salemi, and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board”), the Honorable Cathleen Cossident Italia, Anthony J. Prignano, Arturo J. Mota, Mary Ramirez Taconi, Jaime Anguiano and Anthony N. Abruzzo, having taken office on April 30, 2009, constitute the duly elected, qualified and acting officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously entered into an agreement with Kings Point General Cement, Inc. (the “Contractor”), whereby the Contractor was to perform construction and general maintenance work related to the 2009 General Maintenance Sidewalk Program (MFT Section No. 09-000000-01-GM), specifically involving the construction and repair of various sidewalks in the Village (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Contractor submitted a request for payment (the “Request for Payment”), attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof by this reference as “Pay

Estimate No. 14” dated August 14, 2009, in the amount of Thirty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Seven and 90/100 U.S. Dollars (\$37,377.90), pursuant to its agreement with the Village for services rendered in connection with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer, Edwin Hancock Engineering Co., recommended that the Request for Payment be approved, subject to certain qualifications and review, and has submitted its recommendation to the President and Village Board, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “B” and made a part hereof by this reference; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 01. Incorporation Clause.

All of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct, and the Village Board does hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 02. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to approve the Request for Payment.

Section 03. Invocation of Authority.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

Section 04. State Law Adopted.

All applicable provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Municipal Code, as may be amended from time to time, relating to the purposes of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Sections 05 - 09. Reserved.

**ARTICLE II.
AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYMENT APPLICATION**

Section 10.00 Approval of Request for Payment.

That the Request for Payment is hereby approved in substantially the same form, specifications and amount as particularly described in Exhibit "A" as modified by Exhibit "B".

Section 10.01 Other Actions Authorized.

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the transactions contemplated by this Ordinance and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any documents required to be delivered in connection with the Request for Payment.

Sections 11.00 – 15.00 Reserved.

**ARTICLE III.
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES,
PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE**

Section 16.00 Headings.

The headings for the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

Section 17.00 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section, or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent

jurisdiction, said provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section, or part shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the Village Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section, or part thereof been included.

Section 18.00 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 19.00 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.




