Commercial, Industrial, and Multi-Family Building Owners

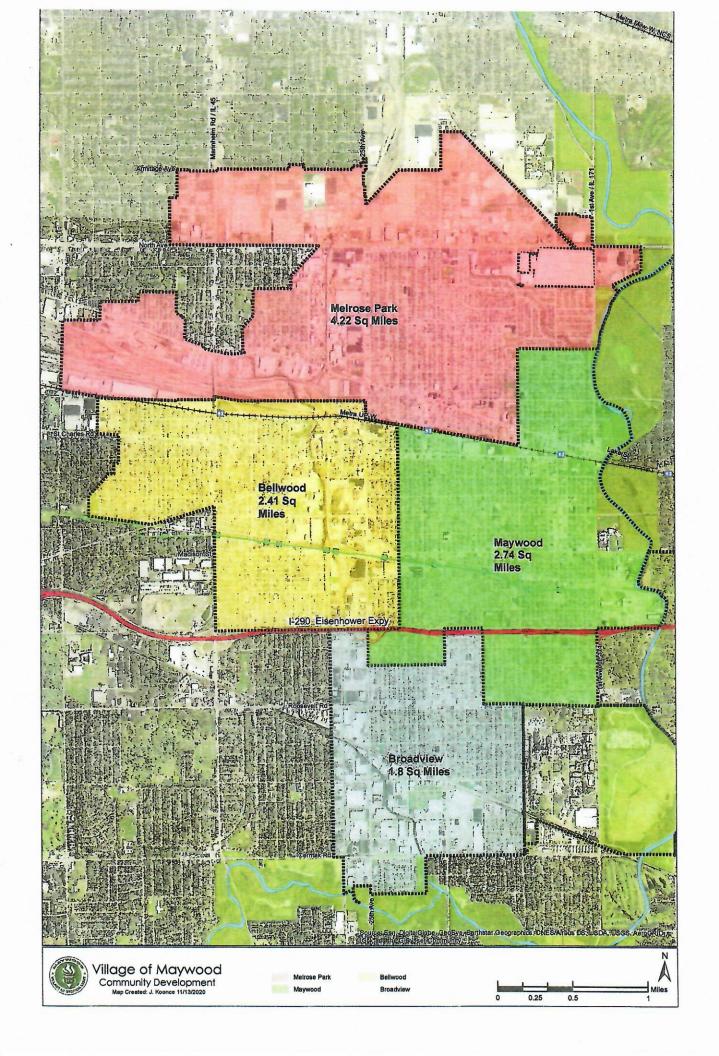
Melrose Park is now part of the West Regional Enterprise Zone. Certify your permit for remodeling, rehabilitation, or new construction projects and receive a Sales Tax Exemption on all building materials for Melrose Park permitted Commercial, Industrial or Multi-Family projects.

Here are your benefits:

- Investment Tax Credit: The State of Illinois allows a .5% credit against state income taxes for investments in qualified property used in an enterprise zone.
- Jobs Tax Credit: Employers in an Enterprise Zone may obtain a \$500 tax credit on their Illinois income taxes for hiring dislocated or economically disadvantaged individuals.
- Illinois Sales Tax Exemptions: 7.75-10% Illinois sales tax exemption on building materials for use in real estate located in the West Regional Enterprise Zone; remodeling, rehabilitation, or new construction.
- Building Materials: Sale Tax Exemption on building materials.
- Machinery or Pollution Control: a similar 6.25% state sales tax exemption is available on purchases of personal property used in the assembly or manufacturing process or in the operation of a pollution control facility within an Enterprise Zone. Eligibility for this exemption is contingent upon a business making a Five Million Dollars and 00/100 (\$5,000,000) investment which causes the creation of 200 full-time equivalent jobs. A business must make an application to DCEO for this exemption.
- Utility Tax Exemption: A state utility tax exemption on gas, electricity and telecommunications is available to businesses located in Enterprise Zones.
