Snow piles and windrows from resident and business snow removal operations create a hazard to vehicular traffic and make it more difficult for snowplows to clear the streets. The Village Code prohibits shoveling, moving or otherwise relocating snow into Village streets. Violating this section of the Village Code may result in a fine.

We ask that when clearing your driveway and walks, to please place the snow in your yard, not the street. Snowplow drivers try to minimize any excess snowplow windrowing into cleared drives; however, the plowing process regrettably pushes some snow back into the cleared drives. Depositing snow on the street simply adds more to your drive after the next plowing cycle.

Additionally, please be aware that when snowfall accumulates to at least two inches in depth, parking is prohibited on Village streets until snow removal operations are completed. Parking on a Village street when snowfall exceeds two inches may result in a fine.

Thank you for your assistance during this and every snow season. Patience and cooperation during the snow removal season is a benefit to all.
